
# Waikato-Tainui Indigenous River Symposium

In 2012 the inaugural Waikato River Symposium provided a forum where tribal members and stakeholders were able to share common interests, experiences and aspirations about our Awa Tupuna, the Waikato River. In 2016 Waikato-Tainui Indigenous River Symposium broadens its focus to include koorero from our indigenous whaanau from North America and Canada about their experiences and aspirations for their natural resources.

Knowledge and information will be shared through a range of panel discussions made up of people from our own Iwi as well as across the River Iwi. The panels will be joined by Senior Executives who are holders significant portfolio's for various Iwi, Corporate and Government organisations across Aotearoa.

The Symposium will close on the 20<sup>th</sup> of October with an early evening Haakari (Dinner) featuring Adam Whauwhau and representatives of Te Kaheru Matarau a Hauaa Kapa Haka.
